The successful applicant will have the following minimum qualifications:

- Certificate of Qualification as a Journeyman Powerline Technician (434A) issued by Skilled Trades Ontario or an equivalent recognized apprenticeship and certification program. Consideration may also be given to registered fourth-year Powerline Technician apprentice who is actively progressing toward certification.
- Must be proficient in the use of all equipment associated with the Powerline Technician trade
- Must be able to perform work from work instruction specifications and standards and to interpret prints, sketches, and diagrams;
- Must be able to meet the physical demands of the Journeyman Powerline Technician position (outdoors, climbing, lifting, pulling, and moving in and out of the bucket);
- Ability to deal effectively and courteously with the public and staff.
- Perform scheduled on-call duties and respond to emergency call-outs as required to support service restoration during outages, storms, and other system emergencies.
- When on-call, be available to respond and report to the Grimsby Power Operations Centre at 231 Roberts Road, Grimsby, within 35 minutes under normal driving and weather conditions.

Education, and Required Licenses:

- Certificate of Qualification as a Powerline Technician (434A) or equivalent, or a registered fourth-year Powerline Technician Apprentice who is actively progressing toward certification.
- A high school diploma with a minimum of Grade 12. A Community College Diploma in electrical technology or a related field of study is an asset;
- Valid Class 'AZ' 'AZ' (restricted) or 'DZ' driver's license and an excellent driving record
